

Symposium on Research and Innovations in Cyber Security (SRICS-2019) (27th March 2019)

CALL FOR TECHNICAL POSTERS (Poster Papers)

SRICS 2019 welcomes technical poster papers from UG/PG students and Ph.D. scholars (Research Scholars) affiliated to academic institutes. This is an opportunity for academia and industry to showcase domestic/homegrown research to, and engage with, an audience apropos ongoing work, including new ideas, initial results, open questions, development plans, etc. in the domain of cyber security.

Theme/ Tracks (but not limited to)

- Cryptography and Information Security
- Cyber Security
- Blockchain Technology
- Software Security
- Big Data Security
- Digital Forensics
- Web Security
- Wireless and Mobile Security
- Cloud Security
- IoT Security

Eligibility & Submission

- Poster papers can be submitted by UG/PG students and PhD scholars from legal entities which are recognized institutes
- Each poster can have a minimum of 1 author and maximum 3 authors from the same or different institute.
- There can be a maximum of 5 entries per institute
- Submissions are to be done online only through the Easy Chair portal.
- Poster paper should be up to 4-pages (A-4 size) of concept note (short paper) in WORD DOC/ DOCX format.
- You may refer popular standard templates, such as <https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html>
- The concept note (short paper) should bring out, through text and any illustrations (both together within 4 pages only) : Description of ongoing work including new ideas, initial

results, open questions, development plans, etc. with potential to contribute to cyberspace research/ practice

- Technical poster cover parameters such as: abstract; what problem was addressed; why the problem is important; how the problem was addressed; what were the findings and their practical implications; what is planned as the future work; references (at least 5); acknowledgements (if any), etc.
- Poster, in A0 size, in PDF format; preferably in portrait layout, based on the 4-page concept note (short paper), with the following in mind:
 - A0 size is 46.8 inches vertical; 33.1 inches horizontal
 - Upper and Lower margins; Left and Right margins; should be at least 5 cm
 - Poster should be readable from 1.5 meters
 - TITLE (in poster): Minimum font size should be 72pt; font style in accordance with body-text font
 - BODY TEXT (in poster): Minimum font size should be 36-40pt.
 - Poster should highlight key aspects of your 4-page short paper – summarizing the key points in words and illustration.
 - Do not overload poster with text ('Less is More').
 - Maintain a balance between words and illustrations.
 - Use graphs/ tables/ images/ visual symbols as much as possible, ensuring that graphics are in high-resolution.
 - Poster background (color etc) should not overshadow the foreground text or images.
 - As a best practice, check if the poster can be understood without oral explanations
- Authors are responsible for ensuring there is no plagiarism, and that all references/ sources are duly mentioned
- Author/s should come with printed poster in described format on the day of the symposium for poster presentation

Review/ Acceptance/ Display

- All entries will be reviewed by reviewers for appropriateness and completeness (validity check), and only the eligible entries will be considered.
- Reviewers may also share comments where required, for any revisions.
- Based on the reviewer's assessment, select valid entries shall be considered for physical display during the symposium, subject to physical presence at the symposium of at least one author.
- Reception-style allows poster authors to engage with visitors, with audience walking between the posters and talking with the authors.

Symposium Registration

- Registration will be confirmed for one author (preferably the Lead Author) for every entry selected for physical display during the Symposium.
- Requests (for symposium registration) may be considered for the co-author (if any), OR 1 member of the academic staff (or mentor) from the institute concerned, of entries selected for physical display however he/she should register for the symposium.
- The physically displayed entries will be assessed during the symposium.

Recognition & Awards

- Technical Poster presentation certificates shall be issued to all physically displayed entries (conditional to presence of at least 1 author during the symposium).
- Top 4 physically-displayed entries will be considered for awards during the symposium.

First Prize: INR 8000/-
Second Prize: INR 6000/-
Third Prize: INR 4000/-
Appreciation Prize: 2000/-
