# HOSTEL ADMISSION NOTIFICATION 2018-19. (For F.Y. B. Tech. to Final Year B. Tech)

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR HOSTEL ADMISSION:**

- 1. The admissions are branch wise and on merit basis (CGPA/CET/GMN. BASIS) and as per State Govt. reservation rules.
- 2. Merit list will be prepared on CGPA & having no backlog courses. The students having backlog **courses** will have Second choice in hostel admission.
- The students having more than <u>Three backlogs</u> (including dropped/ unsuccessful, failed/ detained courses) will not be considered for allotment of hostel.
- 4. The students found in **misconduct** in hostel will not be eligible for hostel admission.
- 5. It is mandatory to pay full hostel fees by online mode only.
- 6. Hostel administration reserves the right to deny admission or cancel admission at any stage.
- 7. F.Y. B. Tech hostel allotment will be as per General Merit Number and branch wise. Once a student is allotted hostel admission, subsequent change in branch will not lead to change in hostel allotment.
- 8. Hostel Facility is only for four years.

#### **HOSTEL FEE STRUCTURE (For Boys & Girls) for 2018-19.**

### (A) Hostel Fees for Two Semesters (Odd & Even)

- 1. Hostel fees for Regular students: Rs. 27,000/- year / student.
- 2. Hostel fees for NRI/FN/Gulf/PIOs: Rs. 90,000/- year / student.
- 3. Hostel Deposit for all students (Refundable): Rs 5,000/ student.
- 4. Hostel Mess Deposit for Boys (Refundable): 5,000/ student.
- 5. Hostel Mess Deposit for Girls (Refundable): 5,000/ student.

### (B) Hostel Fees: For stay in Hostel during Vacation period

- 1. Academic Activity- Rs. 1,000/- per student.
- 2. Non-Academic Activity Rs. 2,000/- per student.

The Maharashtra Legislative Council has passed a bill (MAHARASHTRA ACT No. XXXIII OF 1999, THE MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999) to prohibit ragging in educational institutions in the State of Maharashtra on 7<sup>th</sup> April 1999. As per this bill-

- Whosever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall on conviction be punished, as per the rules.
- Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted to any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
