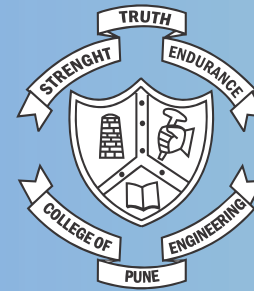

About COEP

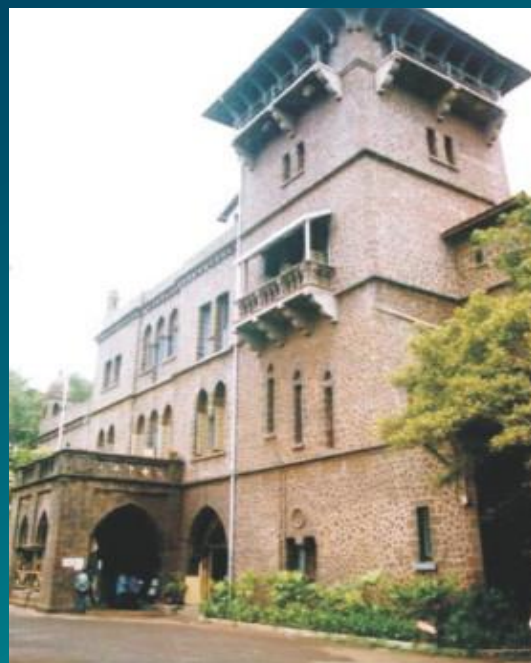
