

COEP signs MOUS with GTT and NASSCOM for enhancing student employability.

College of Engineering, Pune has signed MOUs with GTT and NASSCOM to provide Business Skills Programme for first year to final year B. Tech & M.Tech students under National Skill Development Council (NSDC). The objective of these MOUs is to improve the quality and quantity of the employable workforce for industries through various training programmes organized at the academic institutes.

GTT in association with Cisco has set up the Cisco Education Enabled Development (CEED) Academy at the institute which will offer training in Job skills to COEP students through various programmes and lectures delivered by experts from all over the world. Equipments worth Rs. 4,50,000 along with the software licence would be made available (free of cost) under the MOU.
