College of Engineering Pune, an Autonomous Institute of Government of Maharashtra has adopted credit based evaluation system. At the end of every semester, a student is awarded a Letter grade based on his/her performance in mid-semester, tests, /assignments/quizzes and end-semester examinations in every course registered by him/her. Institute has adopted a 10-point scale similar to the one followed in IITs. The description on the grades and grade points are as follows.

Grade	Grade Points
AA	10
AB	9
BB	8
BC	7
CC	6
CD	5
DD	4
FF	0

SGPA is calculated based on the courses completed every semester. Similarly CGPA is calculated based on all the courses completed till that semester. Thus the CGPA is calculated on a scale of 10. Academic Senate in its 36th Meeting held on 14th December 2015 has approved the conversion of CGPA to Percentage of Marks as mentioned below. This conversion of CGPA is applicable for the batches admitted in First Year from Academic Year 2015-2016 onwards.

Formula to convert CGPA into Equivalent Percentage of Marks:

Percentage of Marks: [CGPA-0.5] X10

Academic Senate in the said meeting has further approved CGPA of 8.0 and above shall be considered as First Class with Distinction since $[8.0-0.5] \times 10 = 75 \%$ and CGPA of 6.5 and above, but below 8.0, shall be considered as First Class since $[6.5-0.5] \times 10 = 60 \%$.
