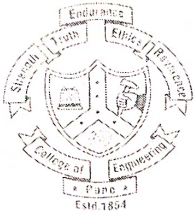

After that agenda items were taken up and board decided/ recommended as under

The agenda of the meeting was as follows:

- 1) Curriculum of final year B.Tech (Civil)
- 2) Course content of courses for B.Tech Civil Honors
- 3) Course content of courses for Minor in Civil Engineering

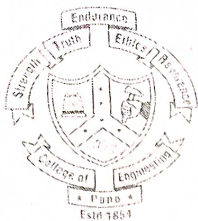
All the points on the agenda were discussed in the following sequence:

Prof. A.D. Thube presented the structure of courses to be implemented for semester 7th and 8th in a next academic year.

The discussion carried out in the meeting and the arrived conclusions are as follows:

Discussion on honors subject was carried out.

1. Maximum number of students should be fixed for each elective, so that all offered elective will run. At least one elective from each stream should be offered. Mr. Ramgude has suggested that Engineers from industry should be allowed to register for elective courses of their area of interest. Student representative Vrushali Garde also insisted allocation of subject even if less number students will be interested in particular elective subject
2. Dr. M.U. Khobragade presented the syllabus of Waste water engineering. During the discussion of syllabus of Waste water engineering, the industry members suggested the modification of COs and allocation of names to each chapter. Mr. Ramgude has suggested the addition of Ozone treatment and patented waste water treatments in the syllabus.
3. Mr. Ramgude has suggested that at least 30% syllabus of mathematical subjects should be based on Civil Engineering applications.
4. Prof. Madhekar presented the syllabus of Introduction to Earthquake Engineering. Addition of introduction of performance based design in the Introduction to Earthquake engineering subject is suggested by Mr. Ramgude. During the discussion of syllabus it was suggested that software must be made a part of assignment in Introduction to Earthquake engineering subject.
