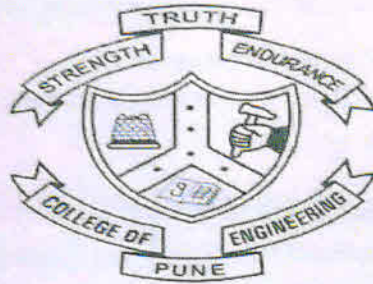


Memorandum of Understanding

Government College of Engineering Karad

The MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) between **College of Engineering, Pune** and **Government College of Engineering, Karad** is signed on 7 Jan 2021

This MOU entered into between College of Engineering, Pune (Hereafter called **COEP**) and Government College of Engineering, Karad (Hereafter called **GCEK**) represented in this MOU by the respective Directors on behalf of Board of Governors, of their Institutes, which shall mean and include their successors in interest and assigns.

SCOPE AND OBJECTIVE OF MOU

In order to make the academic and research cooperation between the two institutions viz. COEP and GCEK, the scope and objective of MOU are defined as:

COEP and GCEK agree for **academic, student's career and research cooperation** between all their departments.

DURATION OF MOU

The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of 3 years from the date of signing the MOU.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF COE, PUNE AND GCE, KARAD

- ❖ The COEP and GCEK mutually agree to identify the various areas of interest and depute faculty on exchange basis up to six months or as per requirements for conducting courses or research in various semesters. Both the institutions will meet the TA/ DA of their respective faculty members visiting the other institution. The host institution will provide all boarding and lodging facilities to the visiting faculty.
- ❖ Both the institutions i.e. COEP and GCEK will organize technical competitions, conferences, workshops, seminars, Quiz's etc. The faculty and students shall be encouraged to participate in such activities so as to interact with each other for their academic and professional growth. Such programs will be conducted by both the institutions on regular basis during winter/ summer vacations and informed to each other in advance.
- ❖ COEP and GCEK mutually agree to exchange students for one semester (preferably at Third or Fourth Year) and credits given at the respective institutes will be transferred at the parent institute. For exchange, students **no additional** tuition fee will be charged at each other's institutes **but parent institute will transfer 70% of tuition fee already collected from student**. Both the institutes will provide all the facilities concerning the academics to the

students of each other. However, provision of hostel facility will depend on availability.

- ❖ COEP and GCEK may take the help of each other in the revision of curriculum, evaluation process and to find out the commonalities to facilitate the exchange of faculty.
- ❖ COEP and GCEK mutually agree to help each other to establish and develop laboratories, research centers, etc., as and when required.
- ❖ Faculty of COEP and GCEK depending on their qualifications and experience can act as supervisor to the students pursuing their M. Tech and PhD programs at COEP or GCEK as the case may be.
- ❖ Both the institutes will help each other to conduct short courses, cultural projects, study tours.
- ❖ Areas for staff development shall be identified for training of faculty/staff of both the institutes for their academic growth.
- ❖ Areas for R & D projects, design and consultancy shall be identified and joint proposals shall be submitted to various funding agencies like MHRD, DST and AICTE etc.
- ❖ Both the institutes will help each other in enhancement of Industry Institute Interaction, exchange of information about proper / right training agencies.
- ❖ Both the institutes will help each other in placement especially when industry needs a large pool of students.
- ❖ Both the institutes will help each other in industry collaborations. (Industry sponsored projects and facilities required to complete such projects).

AMENDMENT TO THE MOU


No amendment or modification of this MOU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to an amendment of this agreement. The modification/ change shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed unless otherwise agreed to.

ARBITRATION

In the events of any dispute or difference between the parties hereto, such disputes or differences shall be resolved amicably by mutually discussion of the Directors of the two institutes.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises the parties have signed the Memorandum of Understanding 07th day of Jan 2021.



