## TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

College of Engineering Pune, an Autonomous Institute of Government of Maharashtra has adopted credit based evaluation system. At the end of every semester, a student is awarded a Letter grade based on his/her performance in mid-semester, tests, /assignments/quizzes and end-semester examination in every course registered by him/her. Institute has adopted a 10- point scale similar to the one followed in IITs. The description on the grades and grade points are as follows.

Grade	Grade Points
AA	10
AB	9
BB	8
BC	7
CC	6
O CD	5
DD	4
FF	0

SGPA is calculated based on the courses completed every semester. Similarly CGPA is calculated based on all the courses completed till that semester. Thus the CGPA is calculated on a scale of 10. There is no Provision of Conversion of CGPA into Percentage of Marks. However, for your purpose, you may treat the equivalence given by AICTE New Delhi as given in the below table as reference.

CGPA	<b>Equivalent Percentage</b>	
8.25	75	
7.75	70	
7.25	65	
6.75	60	
6.25	55	

Based on above table, the following formula is proposed to convert CGPA into Equivalent Percentage and as per AICTE a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA shall be considered equivalent to first class/division. This provision is applicable to the students admitted in first year from Academic Year of 2007-2008 to 2014-2015.

Formula to convert CGPA into Equivalent Percentage of Marks:

Percentage of Marks: [CGPA-0.75] X10
